An absurd dramatic comedy about an overly dedicated travel agent, 38 suffering from burnout with some startling revelations ahead.



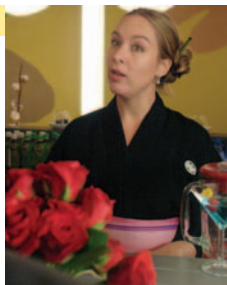
2. Rapunzel ~ The Blonde Years (4 mins)

Rapunzel is desperate to escape her tower prison. The handsome Prince discovers size really does matter when trying to rescue her.



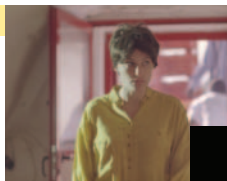
3. Happy Tobikomaki (13 mins)

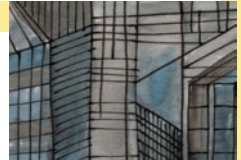
4. L'Oro Rosso (12 mins)
